## **Young new mayor; Vest joins council**

ADA – Effective immediately, the Ada City Council has taken on a new look.

During Monday’s installation ceremony at East Central University, council members unanimously selected Barbara Young as mayor. Two months ago, she was re-elected as Ward 4 representative. Ward 4 is roughly equivalent to the southwest quadrant of the city.

This marks the beginning of Young’s sixth two-year term on the Ada City Council. This is her second stint as mayor. At-large council representative Roger Cupps will serve as vice mayor for the second consecutive year.

Charlie Vest joins the Ada City Council as the new Ward 2 representative, filling the seat vacated by Frank Stout. This is Vest’s first-ever term. Ward 2 is roughly equivalent to the northeast quadrant of the city.

Rounding out the council are Ward 1 (southeast) representative Dick Scalf and Ward 3 (northwest) representative Darrell Nemecek.

The Ada City Council meets on the first and third Monday of each month, unless the Monday falls on a holiday. In those cases, the council meets the following Tuesday.

All council meetings begin at 5:45 p.m. at Ada City Hall and are open to the public. Meetings are also televised live on Channel 11.
