A RESOLUTION AMENDING WATER, SEWER AND SOLID WASTE  
FEES AND CHARGES AS PROVIDED BY THE  
CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ADA, OKLAHOMA.

WHEREAS, THE Code of Ordinance of the City of Ada, Oklahoma provides that the fees and charges for various City functions and services shall be set by motion and/or resolution of the City of Ada, Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of May, 2017, the City of Ada enacted Resolution 17-09A and the Ada Public Works Authority enacted Resolution 17-04P; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ada, Oklahoma and the Board of Trustees of the Ada Public Works Authority have determined that Section One of Resolution No. 17-09A (City) and Resolution No. 17-04P (APWA) should be amended as provided herein; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ada, Oklahoma, and the Board of Trustees of the Ada Public Works Authority have determined that the amended effective date set forth in this resolution is fair and reasonable.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Ada, Oklahoma, and the Board of Trustees of the Ada Public Works Authority:

SECTION ONE.

THAT the following amended effective date is hereby established in the City of Ada, Oklahoma, and Section One of both Resolutions No. 17-09A(City) and Resolution 17-04P(APWA), establishing the effective date, is hereby amended by replacing subsections (c) and (d) and adding subsection (e) as follows:

SECTION ONE

...

- (c) The rates for **water furnished in bulk** shall be as follows:  
First 200 cubic feet or 1,500 gallons - \$75.00 minimum; All thereafter: \$0.05 per gallon or \$0.0375 per cubic foot (of which \$10.50 per month will be allocated to the Water Development Fund\*)
- (d) The rates for water furnished through the use of fire hydrants shall be the same as rates for water furnished in bulk as shown in (c) above.
- (e) That the effective date of subsection 1 shall be May 1, 2017.

SECTION TWO.

The remainder of Resolutions 17-09A (City) and Resolution 17-04P (APWA) shall continue in force and effect as previously adopted.

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Ada, Oklahoma and the Board of Trustees of the Ada Public Works Authority have determined that Section One of Resolution No. 16-11A (City) and Resolution No. 16-08P (APWA) should be amended as provided herein; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Ada, Oklahoma, and the Board of Trustees of the Ada Public Works Authority have determined that the amended effective date forth in this resolution is fair and reasonable.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Ada, Oklahoma, and the Board of Trustees of the Ada Public Works Authority:

**SECTION ONE.**

**THAT** the following amended effective date is hereby established in the City of Ada, Oklahoma, and Section One of both Resolutions No. 16-11A(City) and Resolution 16-08P(APWA), establishing the effective date, is hereby amended by replacing subsections (c) and (d) with the following:

**SECTION ONE**

...

(c) The rates for **water furnished in bulk** shall be as follows:

First 200 cubic feet or 1,500 gallons - \$75.00 minimum; All thereafter-----\$.05 per gallon or \$.037 per cubic foot (of which \$10.50 per month will be allocated to the Water Development Fund\*)

(d) The rates for water furnished through the use of fire hydrants shall be the same as rates for water furnished in bulk as shown in (c) above.

**SECTION TWO.**

The remainder of Resolutions 16-11A (City) and Resolution 16-08P (APWA) shall continue in force and effect as previously adopted.
