All of Lot 16 in Block 20 of the Original Townsite of Ada The property is generally located at 400 West 4th Street. (If passed, must consider Emergency Clause.)

Staci Bungard, Community Development Director addressed the council on the rezoning application item. This is approximately 7000sq. feet lot and the applicant intend to construct duplex housing. The applicant listed is Demetrius Williams. There was no opposition to the planning and zoning meeting and staff does recommend approval.

Staci Bungard, Community Development Director addressed the council on the rezoning application for this item. This is one vacant lot with an additional lot and current structure. The proposed long-range plan does support the change from R-1 to R-2 and no opposition was expressed at the planning and zoning meeting. Staff does recommend approval. The current applicant is LunerFour Four Ventures, LLC4 out of Broken Arrow and application was submitted by Will and Laura Brigman.

Council member Vazquez asked about the ADU or accessory dwelling units on the property, Ms. Bungard advised those would fall under the permitted type of structs for this location.
