The city's portion will be about \$90,000. Council Member Vazquez inquired about the draw on the grant funds and who is responsible for this process. Shelly stated that the project is inspected by our staff, then the invoices are submitted to Shelly for approval, then sent to the purchasing office for payment. The Finance Director is responsible for requesting the drawing on the grant funds.

Pam Mckinzie, Purchasing Director, addressed the council on the bid process. Five bids were sent out and 2 were rejected due to incomplete applications. The remaining 3 bids meet the requirements of the CDBG process and Craft Reynolds was within the grant budget and the lowest most responsible bid at \$274,802.

Council Member Vazquez inquired about the project specifics. Pam McKinzie stated that the project is to remove the outside sidewalk at Glenwood Park and relocate it inside the park, with new fencing and new lighting.

Motion made by Council Member Vazquez to award the bid to Craft Reynolds as the lowest most responsible bid at \$274,802.00 for the CDBG grant on Glenwood Park Improvements and authorization for Mayor or her designee to execute all documents related to said project, including but not limited to Notice of Award, Contract, Notice to Proceed.
